- Why would you like to work for this company?
- What would a former employer tell us about you?
- Why did you leave your last job?
- Where do you see yourself in 5 years?
- Tell us about a time that you were asked to lead a team, what skills did you use and how did it work out?
- Tell us about a conflict that you faced and how and how you dealt with it.
- What are your salary requirements?

Questions for Employers

- What does a typical day look like in this position?
- Do you provide professional development opportunities?
- Are there opportunities for advancement?
- What level of responsibility is required in this role?
- What are the next steps in the hiring process?
- When can I expect to hear back about the position?

Questions That Cannot Be Asked During an Interview

- Age or genetic information
- Disability
- Birthplace, country of origin or citizenship
- Gender or sexual orientation
- Marital status, family, or pregnancy
- Race, religion, or ethnicity
- Religious affiliation/beliefs
